Ms. Evans and Ms. Helton have taught SANE training programs at Rutgers University and the New York City Health and Hospital Corporation. They have also presented at various nursing association conferences on the complex issues of domestic violence and sexual assault in the practice of nursing.

Continuing Education

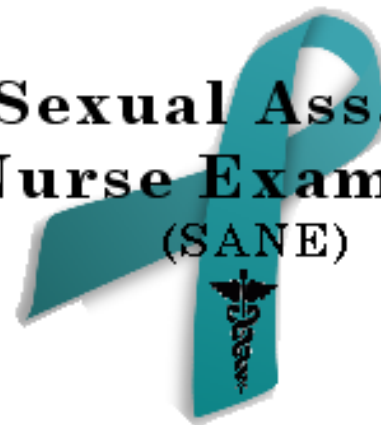

About the SANE TRAINING.....

Sexual assault is a crime that affects thousands of people each year. One in four women will be assaulted in her lifetime. This training provides a foundation for nurses, nurse practitioners and nurse midwives in the complex issues of caring for victims of sexual assault.

Course content will include teaching psychosocial aspects of sexual assault, forensic concepts, documentation, evidence collection, (including photographing injuries) and legal issues. Training will include didactic and experiential sessions with case studies and slides.

OBJECTIVES

At the completion of the training, participants will be able to:

1. Describe role of SANE nurse in caring for a patient after a recent sexual assault
2. Demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the dynamics of sexual assault
3. Demonstrate components of the forensic examination and evaluation of the sexual assault survivor
4. Identify key elements of documentation in a forensic exam, including application of forensic photography, and
5. Discuss legal aspects of the sexual assault crime and the nurse's role.

LOCATION

The course will be held at Columbia State Community College, in the Waymon L. Hickman building, Columbia, TN. More information about the location, including a map of the campus, will be emailed to those who register to attend.

PLEASE NOTE:

This training will also prepare nurses who wish to practice as a sexual assault forensic examiner in emergency rooms or other sexual assault organizations. This training is the first step in becoming SANE-A certified.

Requirements for SANEs vary from state to state; we encourage you to contact your local rape crisis center for details.

Preference will be given to nurses working in Giles, Hickman, Lawrence, Lewis, Marshall, Maury and Williamson Counties.
